With most of its land being used for open space, Grayslake is a picturesque suburb in northern Illinois, located 40 miles north of the Loop.

Gray's Lake, a 78-acre recreational lake, is located in the heart of the community. The village offers over 3500 acres of open space and environmental protection.

Grayslake's Village Center offers a quaint shopping atmosphere in downtown Grayslake. With its historic storefronts, antique lighting, and multitude of small businesses, it is a great escape from the commotion of most malls and shopping centers. Located within the Village Center are some of the schools, an aquatic center, the public library, and the 40-acre Central Park.

The Village of Grayslake is home to the Lake County Fairgrounds. Various events hosted here throughout the year draw half a million visitors to the area.

Schools. Grayslake District 46 and Woodland District 50 serve primary school students in Grayslake.

High school students can attend classes at Grayslake High School in District 127.

Transportation. Grayslake is located west of the Edens Expressway (I-94). A trip to the Loop will take a little under an hour. Chicago O'Hare Airport is a 43-minute drive, while Chicago Midway Airport is a 72-minute drive.

Rail commuters can board Metra's Milwaukee District North Line in Grayslake for an 80-minute commute to the Loop.
