Near North Suburbs



Niles, located 14 miles north of the Loop, sits on the northwest border of Chicago and has seen rapid growth since its incorporation.

Major employers in Niles include Bank One, Coca Cola Bottling Co., Jewel Companies Inc., and Shure Incorporated.

Golf Mill Shopping Center is a large mall located in the heart of Niles. There are many different types of stores including clothing stores, bath and beauty stores, fitness stores, and specialty stores. The mall is also host to larger stores such as JCPenny, Kohl's, Sears, Target, and Value City.

The Niles Park District offers fifteen different parks, a golf course, and two aquatic facilities. The park district also offers programs in athletics, fitness, and educational classes for youths and adults.

Schools. The residents of Niles are served by Districts 63 and 64 for their elementary school classes.

High school students can attend classes in Districts 207 and 219.

Transportation. Niles is at a great spot for commuter accessibility. To the west lies the Tri-State Tollway (I-294), to the east lies the Edens Expressway (I-94), and to the south lies the Northwest Tollway (I-90). Milwaukee Ave. (Illinois Rt. 21), Harlem Ave. (Illinois Rt. 43), and Golf Road (Illinois Rt. 58) are all important north-south highways in Niles.

A trip to Chicago O'Hare Airport will take about 15 minutes, while a drive to Chicago Midway Airport will take around 35 minutes. Palwaukee Airport in nearby Wheeling serves private and corporate aircraft.

Rail commuters can reach the Loop in 25 minutes on two different rail lines that run through Niles.
